General Board - May 17, 2017

The Stewardship team was glad to report that for 2017 our giving vs. expenses "year to date" was positive through March 31. For the first three months of the year:

Expenses	\$45,581
Income	\$57,905
	+\$11,324

We are running ahead of last year and on track for our budget figure for 2017; generally our budget total is higher than we actually spend, but either way we are giving generously as a church and watching expenses wisely.

This is also the time of year we get an annual amount from our permanent funds held in the Christian Church Foundation in Indianapolis; by board action ten years ago, this check from our "Christ the Chief Cornerstone" endowment is shared:

General Fund	\$2,267	20% of total
Outreach	\$2,267	20%
Building Maintenance	\$2,833	25%
Special Missions	\$2,833	25%
and Camp Christian	\$1,133	10%

These will be added to the stated accounts this month and will appear in the next board financial report, and the Camp Christian check has been forwarded on to the regional office.
