## Annual Distribution from Newark Central Funds

Invested with Christian Church Foundation ([www.christianchurchfoundation.org](http://www.christianchurchfoundation.org))

At the end of the first quarter each year, our congregation receives the annual distribution from funds invested by the General Board & Trustees with the Christian Church Foundation (CCF).

The following is a report to the congregation on the status of our accounts, and the distribution of the 2016 receipts.

Central Christian Church has funds invested in two accounts: 1) The Beasley Growth Fund (\$173,237.05) and 2) The Common Balanced Fund (\$53,374.08). Our total balance in both funds at the end of March was \$223,611.13.

Church policy prepared by the Trustees and adopted by the General Board in the fall of 2008 mandates how the receipts are to be used. For 2016 the total receipt was \$10,269.87 and the distribution is:

We have received distributions from these accounts since 2010. Since establishing these "Permanent Fund" accounts, the total received for ministry has been \$67, 019.57.

Under the established policy, any undesignated gifts or estates presented to Central Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) of Newark, Ohio will be placed in the Permanent Fund. An estate of over \$35,000 has been added to the CCF accounts since the distribution.

To add to our ongoing ministry through the Permanent Fund of our congregation, you simply would note in your will that an amount or percentage would go to Central Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) of Newark, Ohio. Some in recent years have established their own named funds with the Licking County Foundation, or left the church bequests with designations of how the proceeds should be used. Please know that any designated gift must be accepted by the Trustees before any terms can be put into effect.

If you are contemplating a gift to the work of this congregation in your will, you may ask any board officer or trustee for information about our work with the CCF. We invite you to consider their support & input on how such a gift can best be made; they have many options for giving such as permanent funds which can be added to during one's lifetime, as well as at death through a bequest.
