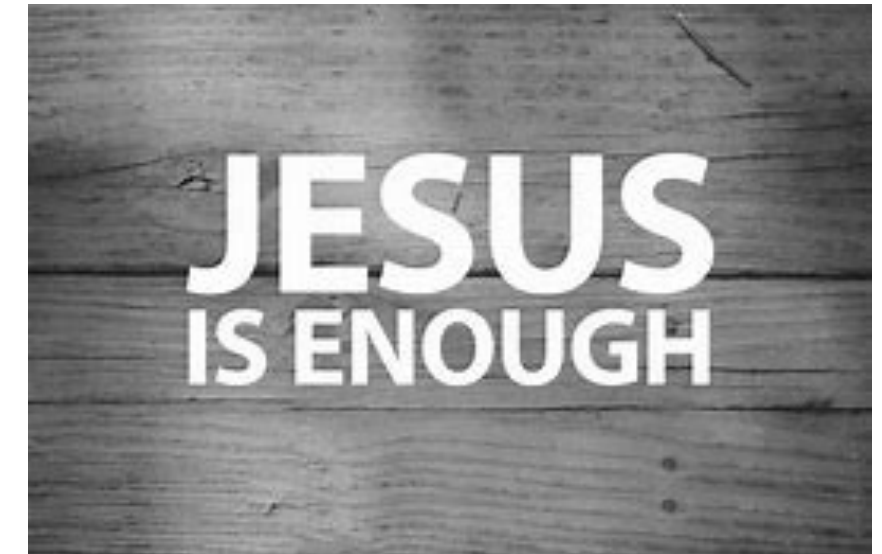

WISDOM ~ The right use or exercise of knowledge; the choice of laudable ends, and of the best means to accomplish them.

In the Book of Proverbs King Solomon shares about wisdom, what it is and how we should use it. King Solomon says this "2 for gaining wisdom and instruction; for understanding words of insight; 3 for receiving instruction in prudent behavior, doing what is right and just and fair; 4 for giving prudence to those who are simple, knowledge and discretion to the young 5 let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance 6 for understanding proverbs and parables, the sayings and riddles of the wise. 7 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction." How will we exercise our knowledge in the coming month? Will we use it for good, to teach those who walk this journey behind us? How can we grow in knowledge to become wiser servants of God's Kingdom?
