The Regional Church Council of the Christian Church in Ohio is meeting at Camp Christian on Friday evening, Oct. 4 and through the day on Saturday, Oct. 5, and their work will not be over that day! There is additional material on the call to prayer & fasting that went out by email & can be obtained at the Welcome Center or by request.

We welcome Cheralyn Hay as our church Business Manager; she will implement our financial processes for invoicing, bill paying, and reimbursements. This is not a return to the former "secretary" model of church office management, and there will not be set office hours she will keep. Everyone has or may ask for Pastor Jeff or Pastor Karen's direct contact information to call or text, and almost any time can be worked out for a meeting or to get someone into the office, but it will not be Cheralyn's job to do that! She will be in and out of the office at various times, working on our accounts and fiscal oversight, but for security reasons will not "buzz in" people unless she already expects someone. If you have a general request or need to be served out of the office, staff checks the voicemail and email daily (see sidebar on front page), so messages can be left at any time. That's still the best way to ask to reserve dates or check the calendar, including the church lodge! We also answer Facebook Messages posted to the Newark Central Christian page usually within hours.
